 - Achieve a passing score on the appropriate subject-matter examination(s). Information about subjectmatter examination(s), including passing scores and registration, can be found in Commission leaflets <u>CL-6748</u> (for Single Subject) or <u>CL-674M</u> (for Multiple Subject), entitled *Verifying Subject-Matter Competence by Examination*.
 - 2. Single subject candidates may complete a Commission-approved subject-matter program or its equivalent and obtain verification of completion from the authorized person in the education department of a California college or university with an approved program. California colleges and universities may have recency requirements that have to be met before subject-matter equivalency can be granted.
- □ Complete course work in developing English language skills, including reading, that is research-based and includes the study of phonemic awareness, spelling patterns, early intervention techniques, ongoing diagnostic techniques, and a strong literature, language, and comprehension component. Submit a copy of the course description for evaluation purposes.
- **U**.S. Constitution Requirement

Individuals must satisfy **one** of the following:

- 1. Complete a course (at least two semester units or three quarter units) in the provisions and principles of the United States Constitution at a regionally-accredited college or university. Submit a copy of the course description for evaluation purposes.
- 2. Pass an examination in the provisions and principles of the U.S. Constitution given by a regionallyaccredited college or university
- □ Satisfy the basic skills requirement, if not previously met. See Commission leaflet <u>CL-667</u>, entitled *Basic Skills Requirement*, for additional information.
- Demonstrate effective use of technology at a foundational level by **one** of the following methods:
 - 1. Complete foundational computer technology course work that includes general and specialized skills in the use of computers in educational settings
