INSTITUTION'S EVALUATION FOR STAFF APPEAL (RGA-16)

Individuals may be eligible to apply for an appeal to obtain their preliminary or clear credential based on provisions outlined in California Code of Regulations Title 5 §80523.2 when a formal recommendation from a Commission-approved program sponsor is not available. This is also known as an RGA-16 appeal.

In such cases, an applicant has completed the equivalent of an approved program but it is not within the institution or agency policy to recommend. Examples of valid reasons the approved program may have for not providing a formal recommendation are:

- 1) The applicant does not meet the residency or recency requirement(s) established by the program or
- 2) The applicant has not been formally enrolled in the preparation program, etc.

This appeal cannot be granted if any approved program requirement is lacking.
