### 2024-25 Annual Data Submission

- ALL Grant funds must be expended by June 30, 2025.
  - The final 10% will be released, or factored into the amount returned
- Grantee must notify the grants team via email by the due date once data reports have been completed.
- All submissions must be satisfactorily met.
- There are no extensions available.
  - Late/incomplete data impacts grant stewardship for the IHE.

### Data is due: June 30, 2025, by 5:00PM

## Funding Scenario- Spent all Grant Funds

**Grant Award:** \$250,000 90% Check: \$225,000 (mailed in 2023) 10% Check: \$25,000 (has not been sent)

**Total Year 1 and 2 Expenditures Reported** \$250,000

Commission will: Mail the final 10% Check (\$25,000) to the IHE's fiscal agent

# Funding Scenario- Grant Funds Remain 1

**Grant Award:** \$250,000 90% Check: \$225,000 (mailed in 2023) 10% Check: \$25,000 (has not been sent)

#### Total Year 1 and 2 Expenditures Reported \$230,000

Unexpended Grant Funds: \$20,000 (less than the 10% check amount)

#### Amount to be sent to the IHE: 10% check - Unexpended funds

\$25,000 - \$20,000 = \$5,000

Commission will: Confirm the amount to be sent to the IHE, adjusted by the final 10% remaining

# Funding Scenario- Grant Funds Remain 2

**Grant Award:** \$250,000 90% Check: \$225,000 (mailed in 2023) 10% Check: \$25,000 (has not been sent)

#### **Total Year 1 and 2 Expenditures Reported** \$190,000

Unexpended Grant Funds: \$60,000 (more than the 10% check amount)

Amount to be returned to the Commission: Unexpended funds – 10% check

\$60,000-\$25,000 = \$35,000

**Commission will:** Confirm the amount to be returned, adjusted by the final 10% remaining

**IHE will:** Mail the unexpended funds to the Commission

### Questions to the Commission

1. Q: We are finding that there are additional opportunities to support funding for recruitment, and the staff/salary costs we predicted have decreased due to shifting roles. What is the preferred process for requesting a categorical shift of funds, if needed.

A: If the changes are above 10% above the <u>total</u> grant award, please email <u>IntegratedGrants@ctc.ca.gov</u>.

Q: Does the team anticipate a no cost extension option?
A: No. This is the final liquidation year.

### Questions to the Commission

Implementation Challenge: We have found that more of the work has fallen to the PIs (grant lead) and the other faculty are sometimes too busy to engage, so we would like to put more funds toward supporting recruitment and increased academic support for those in the ITEP pathway.

Options:

- 1. Shift funds from other categories to recruitment (if category is approved).
- 2. If the changes are more than 10% of the total grant award, contact <u>IntegratedGrants@ctc.ca.gov</u>.

- The 2022-2023 Committee on Budget, Education Finance: Education Omnibus Budget Trailer Bill, AB 181, authorizes the Commission on Teacher Credentialing to allocate \$20 million in one-time grants to regionally accredited institutions of higher education (IHEs) for four-year integrated teacher preparation programs, including student teaching, and/or to adapt an existing Commission-approved five-year integrated teacher preparation program to a four-year program. These grants support the planning for, creation of, or expansion of four-year integrated programs of professional preparation that produce teachers in the designated shortage fields of special education, bilingual education, science, health, computer science, technology, engineering, mathematics, transitional kindergarten, or kindergarten and/or that partner with a California community college to create an integrated program of professional preparation.
