**SUBJECT: Public Hearing Regarding the Proposed Amendments to Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations Pertaining to the Child Development Permit**

---

**Summary**

The Commission on Teacher Credentialing (Commission) proposes amendments to Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR), §80105, 80107, 80109, 80110, 80111, 80112, 80113, 80114, and 80115. The proposed amendments replace the current child development permit requirements with a revised Child Development Permit (CDP) matrix adopted by the Commission in February 2025 (see [Agenda Item 4B](#)) and subsequently updated and adopted in February 2026 (see [Agenda Item 1C](#)). As a result of the revised CDP Matrix, revisions to the Definitions were also added to clarify and make specific new terms. Additionally, outdated language to the application process is also proposed to be revised for consistency with existing regulatory language referencing application requirements.

### **Public Comment Guidelines**

*Participants at the Commission Office:* Individuals who attend the public hearing at the May Lee State Office Complex will need to submit a *Request to Make Public Comment* card to the meeting moderator. The meeting moderator will notify the individual when it is their turn to speak. At that time, the individual will be able to approach the microphone and share their comment.

*Participants via Zoom Webcast:* Individuals who join the meeting via the Zoom webcast will need to click on the "raise hand" icon to inform the meeting moderator that they would like to speak on the item. The meeting moderator will notify the individual when it is their turn to speak by calling their Zoom ID (name used by the member of the public when logging into the meeting). At that time, the individual will be prompted to unmute their microphone and will be able to share their comment.

**Note:** *The Zoom ID name used by the member of the public to join the Zoom meeting will be displayed to the public when the individual provides public comment.*
