Must be AA/BA degree applicable or non-remedial

Core coursework **must** meet the minimum unit requirement of 3 semester units (4 quarter units)

General Education Notes

*Bachelor's degree or higher **clears** general education requirement

All grades must be "C" or better (Pass, Credit and Satisfactory is acceptable if units are earned)

Must be AA/BA Degree applicable or non-remedial

Work Experience Notes

It must be in a childcare or development program setting, ages **five years or younger**

The experience letter or form must state that the applicant worked full-time or at least **three hours per day**

Experience must be within the last **2 years** for the Associate Teacher Permit. For all other permits, experience must be within the last **4 years**

Work experience **cannot** be accepted in lieu of the supervised field experience course
